Many times, they come to us with no one to lean on and could not imagine choosing life. Christina praised the tremendous *courage* they muster in the face of uncertainty. They show great trust in God's Providence when they choose life – more trust than many of us have ever had to call upon.

We fight the irresponsibility, recklessness and insanity of our culture that results in unwanted pregnancies. Yet God brings good out of evil and always gives us hope. MAUBC is hope personified. As with the words of *Amazing Grace*, "...and when I think of God, His Son not sparing, I scarce can take it in," we likewise can scarcely take in what a blessing it is to have here in our community this saver of lives that Mike and Peggy O'Dea humbly and obediently started almost 35 years ago.

We have this rare opportunity to save the lives of many mothers and their babies. There are not many greater opportunities to affect such a positive impact on a world thirsting for justice and holiness.
