JACK'S JOURNAL FROM OUR CHAIRMAN

Dear friends and benefactors,

It's instructive to reflect that World War II erupted just 80 short years ago. Throughout the war, fear was very visible and palpable. It was a terrifying time.

Today we face a more insidious threat – invisible, an atrocity whose significance has yet to register. One that has invaded not only Europe but that is entrenched throughout the world and is devouring us here at home – the threat of godlessness and a complete disregard for God's laws.

God saved this nation and the rest of the world from Hitler. We were so thankful to Him at that time. But like the ancient Israelites, we soon forgot God and how He had saved us. We started buying into subtle untruths that mushroomed into full-bore evil.

Manifesting our ingratitude and depravity, less than 25 years after the end of WWII, most Catholics demanded that Pope Paul VI declare acceptable the practice of contraception. As the pressure grew both inside and outside the Church, the Pope attributed the guidance he received to uphold Church teaching to the Holy Spirit. I wonder what kind of shape our Church would be in today had its laity embraced Humanae Vitae and its priests supported it more vocally.

only the commitment to saving the most defenseless, but encouraging their mothers on God's way to honor and respect their sexuality.

Our work is truly God's work. We celebrate His Divine Providence and Grace to be of one mind with Christ. MAUBC is truly countercultural.

CHRISTINA'S CORNER DIRECTOR OF CLIENT SERVICES

As we approach the fall season, we are proud to look back on the year so far and are excited to think about what the next few months will bring. The work that we do comes with many ups and downs, and it is important as staff, volunteers and supporters that we take time to reflect on the fruits of our labor.



Thank you for allowing us to help mothers overcome obstacles and choose life.

Through August, we have confirmed that 80 moms who came through the Problem Pregnancy Center being abortion-minded or vulnerable have made it to their third trimester (or have given birth) and have chosen life for their babies!

So far in 2018, we have seen 372 clients at our center, performed 263 ultrasound scans, and 84% of our clients were considering abortion when they came to us. The rest were abortion-vulnerable.

We are constantly looking for new ways to improve how we reach out to abortion-minded women. Our efforts to have "abortion shoppers" find us online instead of the local abortion clinics have been a challenge, but we have found promise in a recent digital campaign. Please pray for the success of this campaign. As God works through our ministry, lives are being saved every week. We recently received the following message from a client who was planning on having an abortion:

"I've been meaning to call you. I did not have an abortion, and I am now 32 weeks with a healthy baby girl. I can't wait for her to be here so that I can love all over her. Thank you so much for everything. If I hadn't come into your office that day, I don't know how this would have turned out. Thank you for your encouraging works and for encouraging me to make the best decision for me and my baby!"

Without the generous support from donors like you, none of this work would be possible!

On a personal note, I am excited to share that my husband, Mike, and I are expecting our first baby at the end of January. It has been an incredible experience to minister to pregnant moms while carrying a child myself.
